Racial Profiling Fishbowl Make Up Assignment

If you have an excused absence, and you missed a Fishbowl Activity, here is your make up assignment:

Research an article from a credible source relating to the unit in some way. This article can be about the author, or related to the unit's topic (Racial Profiling/Jim Crow Policing). Type a 500 word response (at least) (in MLA format) responding to the article. IN ADDITION to completing the other required steps as preparation for this Fishbowl (See below).

Fishbowl Prep:

Answer the following on a separate sheet of paper.

- 1. Under what circumstances is it appropriate police procedure to consider race? When is racial profiling illegal?
- 2. What is your impression of Bob Herbert's essay? Is he right?
- 3. What are the dangers of racial profiling?
- 4. How might racial profiling affect individuals and communities?
- 5. What did you find out about "Jim Crow" in Activity 2 (hw).
- 6. How might this relate to your world today? (Think news, social media, etc.)
- 7. What perspective was brought up in the TedTalk? (Watch Melvin Russell's TedTalk, "I Love Being a Police Officer, but We Need Reform")

Research one article (as discussed earlier) and respond. Your response:

- 1. Write down what you thought about the author's use of language, the author's tone, the reason for the author to say what he/she said.
- 2. Think about a sentence or paragraph from the article that made you stop and think, "Wow/I agree/I disagree/Etc.." Explain why this stood out to you. Type the paragraph or the sentence that you are referring to. (The 500 words do not include quotes.)
 - a. Example: In Carnegie's *Gospel of Wealth*, the second paragraph made me think of .
- 3. Remember to type your response on what you thought about that sentence or paragraph. **Do not summarize the article**. "This article is about..." is the start of a summary. **I will not read or grade summaries.**

Format of response:

- a. 12 point font size
- b. Double spaced
- c. Times New Roman
- d. Correct heading: Name, Teacher's Name, Class Name, Date.
- e. Include a header in top right corner.
- f. Indent your paragraphs
- g. No spelling mistakes
- h. No first or second person pronouns. Examples to avoid: "I think Carnegie is saying..." OR "You might think..."

This typed and printed response (or very neatly handwritten) is due in forty-eight hours from the day of the Fishbowl. If it is late one day it will suffer 20%. Two days late or more equals a failing grade. You must turn in your completed pre-discussion questions, research notes, and your make up assignment together.
